Sub : Legal – Revised Guidelines on Conciliation and Settlement Committee (CSC) for establishment of a conciliation and settlement mechanism for contractual disputes under the contract / agreements with the contractors / concessionaires / consultants at Major Ports and Re-constitution of conciliation and settlement committee – Reg.

The copies of the references cited is forwarded herewith which is self explanatory.

The IPA vide reference 1 cited has forwarded the revised / modified guidelines in suppression of earlier guidelines by the Major Port Trusts and KPL with regard to settlement of contractual disputes under the contract / agreement with the contractors / concessionaires / consultants at the Major Ports and requested to be issued after seeking approval from their respective Boards.

Accordingly, the Board vide BR No.127 dated, 17.12.21 has resolved to approve the proposal of the revised guidelines on the conciliation and settlement committee issued by IPA vide order, dated, 4.10.21. and 05.10.21.

Hence, the following shall be adhered to:

- a. Avail the services of Conciliation and Settlement Committee (CSC) in Chennai Port
- b. To include the Clauses for resolving the Contractual disputes through Conciliation and Settlement Committee in the future pertinent agreements.
- c. Also to amend the existing contractual agreement suitably for the Concessionaries who have agreed for resolving disputes through CSC.
- d. Apply the CSC guidelines dated, 04.10.21 & 05.10.21 in all relevant contexts.
